MILSET supports its member organisations to engage youth in STEAM through motivation, cooperation, and networking. We do this by:

Participation: MILSET programmes and activities are open to all.

Ideology: MILSET programmes and activities focus on science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics (STEAM) and are free of political, religious and other ideological agendas or propaganda.

Integrity: MILSET is honest, consistent, and clear in its conduct and relations with members, youth, and others.

Competition: MILSET believes that competition motivates youth to participate in science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics (STEAM); however: MILSET representing member organisations around the world.

- Providing member organisations with global opportunities to engage youth in STEAM

and Regional Expo-Sciences non-competitive events with are a programme that focuses on cooperation, collaboration, networking, and sociocultural interchange. No form of project competition or awards is permitted; youth may be recognised equally for their participation. Other MILSET programmes and activities may include competition, but only if the judging and award winner selection processes are clear, rigorous and equitable. And are conducted by people with recognised expertise in the applicable field(s). The competition that is perceived by participants to have been misrepresented, unfair, inconsistent, or lacking in credibility discourages youth and reflects poorly on the organisation.

WHAT IS MILSET?

The Mouvement International pour le Loisir Scientifique et Technique (MILSET) or the International Movement for Leisure Activities in Science and Technology, in English, is a non-governmental, non-profit and politically independent youth organisation.



MILSET was created in 1987 during the 1st Expo-Sciences International held in Québec City, Canada. Various Regional Offices were progressively established:

Observatoire Midi-Pyrénées

In a historical collaboration, OMP is now MILSET's legal home.

After two years of intense work, on March 27, 2023, the Sub-Prefecture of Muret (Haute-Garonne) in France officially registered the installation of the new international legal seat of MILSET in Toulouse at the facilities of the OMP (Observatoire Midi-Pyrénées), which is part of the University of Toulouse III Paul Sabatier. This historic decision also means that 35 years of activities of MILSET (International Mouvement of Leisure Activities in Science and Technology) have been recognised by the French administration. MILSET is one of the most influential French organisations providing spaces for youth and STEAM leaders to present projects, and ideas, and do networking worldwide.

As MILSET is a non-governmental and non-profit organisation legally constituted in France, it is a great honour that the legal direction has been set in one of the most recognised observatories in the world.

This collaboration will benefit more than 100 youth organisations that are members of MILSET in 80 countries around the world since they will now have as a privileged partner a major research organisation with 350 researchers and 7 laboratories.

MILSET Young Citizens Conferences (YCC) are dedicated to the views and concerns of youth regarding the social impact of science and technology on the modern world, gathering their voices from every part of the globe and encouraging them to actively enter the discussion.

The exponential growth of new technologies and scientific knowledge has generated new and exciting possibilities; however, this has also raised new ethical, social, and ecological issues. We believe that the open-mindedness of young scientists combined with their sense of social responsibility can yield important contributions to the dialogue.

The primary goals of these conferences are achieved through a three-step methodology: Concerns, Discussion and Actions.

Throughout the year, local, regional, and national youth STEAM organisations around the world are invited to organise YCCs on the topic of encouraging youth to discuss their thoughts and propose suggestions based on their knowledge and experience. Conferences follow the three-step methodology: Concerns, Discussion and Actions.

2021

The topic to be discussed for 2022 and 2023 is "Our Future in Space" divided into five subtopics Moon, Mars and planets of the solar system, Space Tourism, Space Debris, New Materials, and Space jobs of the future.

- The National Network of Youth Activities in Science and Technology (REDMex) organised the Mexican Expo-Sciences on December 8, 2022, having 1 keynote speech and 100 participants from 15 to 25 years old.

Description: In the morning scene shown in the photograph, the spiders web above a succulent plant is decorated with dewdrops like a veil of crystal, making the flowers even more delicate. Dewdrop formation is a liquefaction phenomenon. In the warm season, the air is relatively humid, and when the temperature drops gradually, the water vapor in the air cools and liquefies into small droplets that fall on plants and form transparent dewdrops which shine incredibly bright due to total internal reflection. At the same time, the nano-scale natural hydrophobic layer on the plant surface allows the landscape to be preserved.

Description: If you stand by a lake and look down at the water beneath your feet, you will see that the water is transparent and not particularly reflective;

If you look at the lake in the distance, you will see that the water is not transparent, but the reflection is very strong.

This is called the Fresnel effect. This photo was taken in Xia pu tidal-flat area in Fujian Province, China. In the evening, after the low tide, fishermen are fishing for shellfish in the shallow water. The sunset shines on the water, reflecting the light and shadow, creating a unique scene of abundance.

Description: Aurora is a large-scale discharge process around the earth. As part of the solar wind, charged particles rush to the earth at a speed of 3 million kmh.

When they reach near the earth, they are captured by the earth's magnetic field, causing some of them to approach the north and south poles along the field line.

When these charged particles enter the polar upper atmosphere, they collide with atoms and molecules in the atmosphere, which will produce 1 million trillion energies.

Small particles in the earth's atmosphere will release energy; for instance, oxygen atoms emit green or red light, oxygen molecules emit red or yellow light, and nitrogen molecules emit purple or pink light.
